Beverly works on research of deep drilling and the effect on drinking water. With earth movements, ground water can move. She is researching to determine if chemically treated water will stay deep below the earth and out of drinking water.

Beverly's current research projects include field work in Namibia, the Appalachian Basin, and Lake Erie, as well as experimental studies of mineral-brine-CO₂ reactions and flow through porous media. Funding for this research has come from the National Science Foundation, the Environmental Protection Agency, the Department of Energy, the Ohio Coal Research Consortium, and the Lake Erie Protection Fund. Beverly received a B.S., M.S., and PhD. from Massachusetts Institute of Technology.
